PERSONAL PHONE NUMBERS ARE NOT SHARED

Remind messages are not sent from personal cell phone numbers. Students and parents who sign up to receive messages from their teachers will never gain access to a teacher's personal cell phone number, nor will the teacher have access to a student or parent's cell phone number.

Remind does not rent or sell any user data, ever. Remind is also COPPA compliant, and uses standard encryption methods, such as SSL, to protect user information. SAVE VALUABLE TIME

Announcements: Teachers update students and parents in seconds regardless of which device they use. By sending quick Announcements to their entire class using the app or website, everyone is in the loop.

Chat: Teachers can also choose to initiate safe, personalized conversations with individual students or parents. Remind Chats can be paused & resumed at anytime and teachers can set Office Hours so they stay in control of their messages.

EASILY REVIEW MESSAGE HISTORY

A transcript of all Announcements and Chats is available at any time. These messages can never be edited nor deleted. This means an accurate communication history will always be available for reference, which is great for communication logs and general audit requests!

As a verified Administrator, you have access to Teacher accounts when they are linked to a school site. This gives you the ability to manage the subscriber list, export message history and/or delete the account if needed. You can request access using *this form*.

USE FREELY

Remind is completely free to use for teachers, students, and parents. Standard text messaging rates* apply to those receiving messages (based off each individual's messaging plan and cell phone carrier), but there are no added costs. In other words, receiving a Remind message is exactly the same as getting a text message from a friend.

There are no ads and Remind doesn't sell any information.
